Each Week At A Glance

Week 1 (Animal Antics) June 28– July 2. Join us as we investigate the many animal habitats of Seattle, both indoor and outdoor. We will see all that the animal world has to offer without ever leaving the confines of the city. Lions and tigers and bears, oh my!

Week 2 (Variety!) July 6-9: This week has something for everyone: a Storm Basketball game, a trip to the beach, cooking and craft projects, plenty of games and outside time, PLUS an overnight sleepover at Spruce Street School! This is a 4-day week due to the holiday on the 5th, but includes an overnight on Thursday. Pick-up on Friday is at 4:30 pm.

Week 3 (Games and Sports) July 12-16: This week will be full of fun games and sports activities for the athlete in all of us. Run, jump, hop, skip, swim, play ball...you name it, we can do it. Ready? Set? Go!

Week 4 (Festive Food) July 19-23: This week is all about food. Food to eat, food art, food field trips and learning about where food comes from. Bring a favorite recipe to share with the group.
